

Own Boat Training ~ Powerboats

An option for those with access to their own craft is to undertake training on that craft rather than a school boat.

You can either undertake training based around RYA courses or we can structure a bespoke course for you addressing the particular areas that you wish to deal with.

Often we are able to do a bit of both by spending some extra time within a Powerboat Level 2 course on (for example) the launch and recovery of your new boat or how to get to grips with the chartplotter

that you have on board.

We are also able to spend time looking at the safety equipment that you have on board giving impartial advice that can help you make the most of it whilst giving realistic advice on what items you might consider buying.

As an added benefit you will find that Own Boat Training is generally more cost effective with the obvious added benefit that by training on your craft 100% of what we cover is relevant to your particular needs.

Case studies



- **30ft Searay ~ four berth family cruiser:** One day bespoke course focussing on close quarter handling in a marina environment.
- **20ft Avon RIB:** 2 days focussing on passage planning coupled to executing passages to the Yarmouth and Cowes in the Solent. Full use of GPS/Chartplotter coupled to traditional methods.
- **26ft Mariah bowrider:** RYA Powerboat Level 2 course including full provisioning of this new craft from a local chandlers. Instructor guided owners through kit requirements avoiding unnecessary purchases.
- **27ft Ribcraft RIB:** Accompanied delivery to the Channel Islands with the owners undertaking all of the planning for the trip with the Instructor there to give advice as required.
- **12ft speedboat:** One day course following boat purchase to practice launching the craft and close quarter handling.
- **18ft Bayliner:** ICC assessment for experienced owner seeking to trail the craft to France for a holiday.
